<b>Verdelho, Finca la Nina, Argentina</b> .. .. . An Argentinean twist on the Portuguese grape that you really don't see enough. The wine is dry with a lovely floral aroma with crisp citrus and a stone fruit palate			<b>20.50</b>
<b>Muscadet de Sevre-et-Maine, Clos de la Foliette, France</b> .. .. . Grown in one of the coldest and wettest regions of France the grape, Melon de Bourgogne, has high acidity with apple and citrus flavours - great with seafood			<b>22.50</b>
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Witts End, Marlborough, New Zealand</b> .. .. . With all the hallmark aromas of gooseberry and nettles that you would expect from Marlborough, this is crisp, fruity and rather naughty!			<b>22.50</b>
<b>Albarino, Orballo, Rias Baixas, Spain</b> .. .. . Delicate peach aromas with a hint of spice, herbs and traces of sweet fruits, a fresh and crisp palate rounded by hints of honey, peaches and stone fruits – medium body with a floral finish.			<b>24.00</b>
<b>Pouilly Fume Patrice Moreux, France</b> .. .. . This Pouilly Fume displays classic flint and minerality on the palate, balanced by just the right amount of fruit. Classic match with seafood, and totally at home with the cheeseboard.			<b>28.95</b>

Bright raspberry red in colour. Medium bodied, soft, bursting with berry fruit flavours.

A soft and easy wine with generous flavour and a gentle, lasting finish.

<b>Nero d'Avola/ Shiraz, Il Paradisso, Italy</b> .. .. .			<b>16.25</b>
Fine modern winemaking, soft, rounded lightly spicy Nero d'Avola is well balanced by the more familiar dark berried character of Shiraz.			
<b>Cabernet Sauvignon, Welmoed, Stellenbosch South Africa</b> .. .. .			<b>17.25</b>
Dark berry fruits with hints of nutmeg, cassis and vanilla. Ripe, fine tannins with a long lingering finish – great with roast beef or lamb.			
<b>Berry Brothers Good Ordinary Claret, France</b> .. .. .			<b>19.50</b>
Medium to full bodied, dry Cabernet Sauvignon blend. Consistently excellent!			
<b>Shiraz, '2 Up', South Australia</b> .. .. .			<b>21.95</b>
A vibrant shiraz with rich blackberry fruit and hints of plum, dark cherry and spice. The long lingering finish reflects dark berry fruits and fine tannins.			
<b>Cotes du Rhone Parcelles 38, Rhone Valley, France</b> .. .. .			<b>22.50</b>
A blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre, this is a serious Cotes du Rhone, being full flavoured and having the structure to support the ample fruit. Delicious drinking now.			
<b>Shiraz/Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot, Music by D'Aria, South Africa</b> .. .. .			<b>22.50</b>
'Awaken your senses' the bottle tells us...in truth an easy drinking wine for everyday enjoyment. Juicy red fruit and berries on the nose are complemented by vanilla French oak on the palate.			
<b>Pinot Noir, Francesca Bay, NZ</b> .. .. .			<b>25.00</b>
Aged in oak casks, this fine wine has a vibrant colour and a complex abundance of strawberry, cherry and dark berry.			
<b>Claret, Chateau La Croix St Beniot, Bordeaux, France</b> .. .. .			<b>25.95</b>
A Very good concentrated modern claret - old vine Cabernet Franc and Merlot.			
<b>Middelvie Free run Pinotage, South Africa</b> .. .. .			<b>26.50</b>
Sweet raspberry aromas on the nose with mulberry undertones and elegant oak spices. This is a big beautiful drinkable wine but BIG...			
<b>Sancerre Rouge, Dom Hubert Brochard, France</b> .. .. .			<b>30.00</b>
100% Pinot Noir this wine is full bodied and slightly tannic it goes superbly with cooked meats, and all kinds of cheeses. Can be served slightly chilled - just ask. Another favourite.			

## Dessert Wines

<b>Vouvray Moelleux La Levriere, Bourillon d'Orleans – Half bottle</b>	<b>75ml glass 4.00 / Bottle 20.00</b>
Aromas are of ripe pineapple and quince, followed by sweet spices, clove and cinnamon. The palate is awash with flavours of sweet figs and lemon. A superb partner for sweet caramel puddings or strong, creamy cheeses.	
<b>Vistamar Late Harvest Moscatel, Limarí Valley</b>	<b>75ml glass 2.50 / Bottle 14.50</b>
Aromas of white flowers, peach, apricots and quince carry through to a palate of more ripe stone fruits and dried fig flavour. Sticky toffee pudding, fruit cheesecake and blue cheeses are all perfect partners!
